OPERATIONS

AVEK TURNOUT AND STORAGE

Consolidation study is still in process with work being done by a local firm AECOM and CRWA engineers.

9. WATER SERVICE PROGRAM UPDATE:

The application was obtained from Self-Help Enterprises. They indicated that all customers would be eligible, however they should leave the income section blank so as to insure approval. The application will be posted to the website and a notice will be sent in the next billing cycle.

The board requests that an audit be done to reach out directly to those customers not receiving water service.

10. MAINTENANCE AND DISTRIBUTION REPORT:

There were a few supply chain issues with cholrine, but those have been resolved. There was a coliform hit on Well #2 which was treated and flushed. One hydrant was stolen from some abandoned apartments. All reporting is up to date. The quarterly meeting with EPA was November 10th and President Westmorland was in attendance.
